PROGRAM

THE CONCEPT:

The main idea is the mastering, updating and deepening by participants of unique professional, scientific and methodological, pedagogical, social and humanitarian, psychological, legal, economic and managerial competencies, including the study of domestic and foreign experience, which contributes to the qualitative performance of their official duties, extension of their competence.

The purpose – raising the general level of knowledge and acquiring relevant skills of scientists from Ukraine in the context of the lifelong education system regarding management activities and solving complex tasks of ensuring national and international security; achieving the effectiveness of institutional and functional interaction in the public administration system in conditions of uncertainty, global challenges, risks and crises; definition and use of modern tools for the development of a common security space.

Main tasks:

- establishment of contacts with universities, scientific structures and state institutions of relevant fields, taking into account activities in war and post-war period conditions;
- improvement of professional competencies in various scientific fields;
- formation of professional personnel potential, focused on strengthening peace, security and stability in the Euro-Atlantic area and the world in general; promotion of regional security and cooperation; ensuring international security, stability and conflict prevention;
- promoting the coordination of interaction between public administration, business, science and society in conditions of uncertainty, global challenges, risks and crises;
- improvement of analytical and critical thinking skills in the communication system during the presentation of scientific developments and achievements of the European scientific and educational platform;
- obtaining additional and improving the existing knowledge and skills of countering disinformation narratives, ensuring information security, and taking into account the relevant field of professional activity;
- intensification of the development of democracy, increasing the level of openness of state administration, establishing cooperation between citizens, civil society institutions and government bodies of all levels; highlighting and effective use of open governance tools at the local level;
- intensification of individual activity and personality development in the conditions of correspondence and distance learning in the war and post-war period.

THE PROFESSIONAL COMPETENCES:

General (universal) competencies

- educational - the ability to learn and master modern knowledge, innovative methods, and technologies of training and development in conditions of uncertainty, global challenges, risks and crises;
- research - competence in research at a high level, informed decision-making and solving problems and scientific and applied tasks for the safety of man, society, and the state;
- creativity - the ability to generate new scientific, theoretical and practical ideas and to find one's ways of solving problems in the communication system; promotion of mutually beneficial cooperation on matters of common interest, in particular, about the efforts of the international community to confront emerging security challenges;
- ethical - the ability to work in a scientific and professional group based on principles and norms of ethics, the rules of the culture of behaviour in relationships; adhere to the principles of pedagogical ethics;
- emotional intelligence – being aware of their emotional state, self-control and self-regulation; ability to overcome difficulties, stress resistance; general optimistic mood, initiative, positive attitude;
- security – improving the skills of solving complex tasks in conditions of uncertainty and crises to ensure security at the supranational, national, regional and local levels.

Particular (professional) competencies

- research based on the latest achievements of modern theories, as well as based on knowledge about the current state of the country's development;
- the ability to independently develop projects by creatively applying existing and/or generating new legal ideas; the ability to create unique and/or improve existing legal methods of analysis, modelling, forecasting, and solving new problems in new fields of knowledge;
- the ability to evaluate and substantiate the priority areas of strategic development at various levels of public management and administration, to identify and analyze potential threats and risks, to create predictive assumptions regarding their resolution;
- the ability to manage educational activities for the training of specialists in conditions of uncertainty, global challenges, risks and crises with the help of a developed system of didactic tools; the ability to implement effective educational technologies and interactive learning methods;
- the ability to transfer knowledge to the applied plane, generate new approaches to professional activity taking into account the current geopolitical situation;
- ability to apply knowledge skills from the cycle of professional training, which is the theoretical basis for building the content of educational fields;
- the ability to use traditional and modern forms, methods and techniques of education, including distance learning; ways of searching, systematizing, summarizing and using information taking into account contemporary media challenges, ensuring information security;
- the ability to apply knowledge related to the social structure and national specificity of society, with the features of social roles; the ability to determine the spheres of geopolitical transformations in the context of the impact on national and international security;
- the ability to critically understand the general trends of globalization, complex processes and phenomena in the system of public administration and the application of complex approaches to their analysis and forecasting;
- the ability to analyze and correlate the results of modern changes and socio-political transformations in Ukraine and Europe to develop current mechanisms of their implementation for the safety of people, society, and the state;
- the ability to make informed decisions in the public administration system based on the analysis of current problems in conditions of uncertainty and crises to ensure security at the supranational, national, regional and local levels;
- understanding of public participation in the restoration and development of regions and territorial communities; participation of youth in policy formation and implementation.
